

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I sign up for the AfterWork program? Your first step is to talk with an AfterWork advisor who will help you through the admission process. Call (208) 426-1709.

I've been admitted to the university and I'm interested in the AfterWork program. Now what? You'll want to contact the AfterWork advisor at: afterwork@boisestate.edu or (208) 426-1709. The AW advisor will give you an overview of the program and also be able to put you in touch with a specific advisor in your program of study.

Who is the AfterWork program for? The program is designed for working students who have some college experience and are looking to complete their bachelor's degree with a combination of evening, weekend, and online classes.

How long will it take to complete my degree? It depends. Every student comes into the program with a different number of college credits. A minimum of 128 credits is needed (including transfer credits) to graduate with a bachelor's degree. The other factor is how many classes you would like to take a semester. All required classes for AfterWork degrees will be offered at least once every two years in the evenings or on weekends.

My college credits are from 20 years ago – will they still count? While there are some exceptions, most transferable college credits do not expire.

Can I test out of some classes? Yes, Boise State accepts a number of tests for credit, including College Level Examination Program (CLEP) and Dantes Subject Standardized Test (DSST) exams.

Can I do the AfterWork program at one of the off-site locations? Yes! Select AfterWork degrees and/or courses are available at the Gowen Field and Twin Falls sites.
