



# Gowen Field Fall Classes 2009

The classes listed below are available this fall at Gowen Field. The program at Gowen Field is open to military, dependents and the general public. The Boise State office is located in Building #521 at Gowen Field, which is just off Gowen Road south of the Boise airport.

## CLASSES HELD AUGUST 24 - DECEMBER 17

Boise State's Gowen Field Campus offers the core academic classes as well as a wide variety of core classes in all three of the required areas for students to complete an Associate's degree as well as some upper division courses to complete the Bachelor of Applied Science degree. The degrees available to work towards are:

- Associate of Arts Degree (A.A.)
- Associate of Science Degree (A.S.)
- Associate of Science-Criminal Justice Administration
- Bachelor of Applied Science (B.A.S.)\*\*

\*\*Gowen Field Campus offers a small selection of upper division courses that can be applied toward the Bachelor of Applied Science degree program.

**IMPORTANT CHANGE TO FULL-TIME STUDENT STATUS:** Beginning Fall 2009, a full-time undergraduate student at Boise State University will be defined, for fee paying purposes, as a student enrolled in 12 or more credits and 9 or more credits for graduate students. Currently, students taking 8 or more credits are defined as full-time for tuition and fee paying purposes.

**NON-DEGREE SEEKING STUDENTS:** Please note that non-degree seeking students will still be limited to any combination of courses totaling seven or fewer credits;

or a maximum of two courses, even if these courses total more than seven credits.

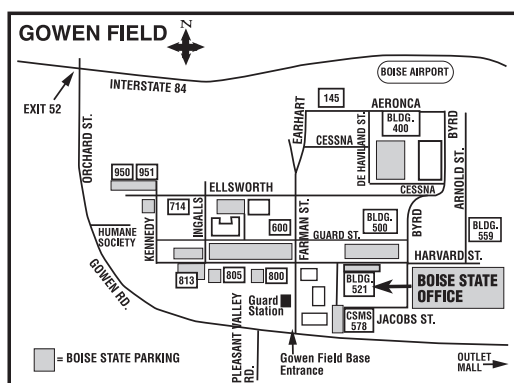
