#### IMPORTANT FEE POLICY

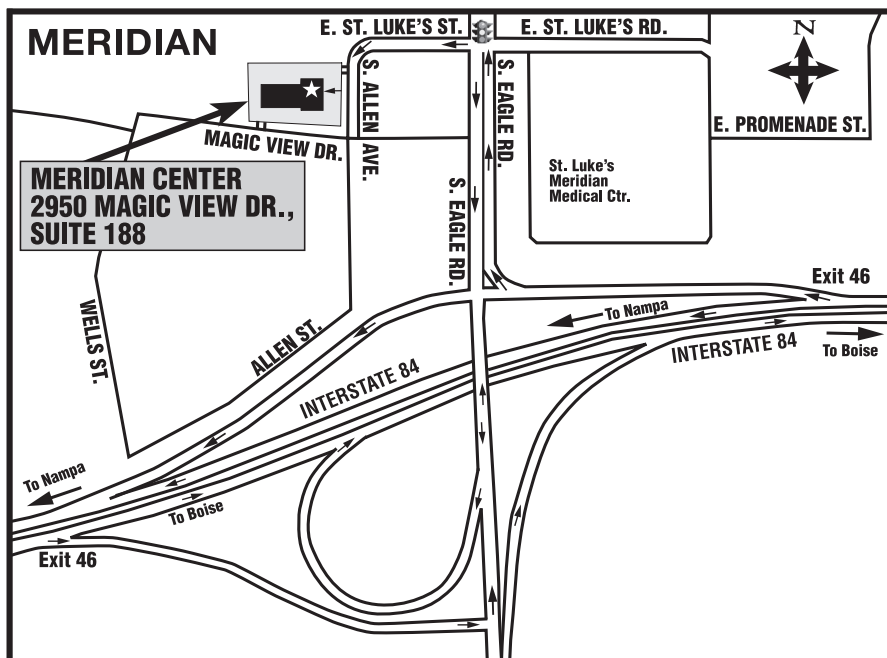
