



Mountain Home Spring Classes 2010

The classes listed below are available this spring at Mountain Home Air Force Base and Mountain Home High School. Boise State's Extended Studies Program in the Mountain Home area is open to military personnel, dependents, people from surrounding communities, teachers and local high school students.

CLASSES HELD JANUARY 19 - APRIL 16

For many years, Boise State Extended Studies has partnered with the U.S. Air Force to offer classes at Mountain Home Air Force Base. The program in the Mountain Home area is open to military personnel, dependents, people from the surrounding communities, teachers and local high school students. Classes are offered in 12-week blocks, one in fall and one in spring, plus a 5-week summer program.

Classes meet evenings on MHAFB and at Mountain Home High School. The program offers the following:

- Associate of Arts (A.A.)
- Associate of Science (A.S.)
- MHAFB Campus offers a small selection of upper division courses that can be applied toward the Bachelor of Applied Science degree program.

IMPORTANT CHANGE TO FULL-TIME STUDENT STATUS: A full-time undergraduate student at Boise State University is defined, for fee paying purposes, as a student enrolled in 12 or more credits (9 or more credits for graduate students). Formerly, students taking 8 or more credits were defined as full-time for tuition and fee paying purposes.

NON-DEGREE SEEKING STUDENTS: Please note that non-degree seeking students are still limited to any combination of courses totaling seven or fewer credits;

or a maximum of two courses, even if these courses total more than seven credits.

SPECIAL REGISTRATION DATES: Priority Military Registration, by appointment, 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. at the Boise State MHAFB office.

NOTE: Non-Military students attending classes at Mountain Home Air Force Base must submit to a background check before being allowed access to the base. Background Check Forms must be submitted for each semester you are attending classes on base. Once you register for classes/workshops, you remain registered and are held responsible for the fees and grades assessed for these classes unless you cancel your registration. *If you do not pay for or do not attend these classes, you are still held responsible for the fees and grades assessed.* If you decide not to attend any classes, you must drop all of them (including classes and workshops that begin later in the semester) by going to BroncoWeb at broncoweb.boisestate.edu no later than **Thursday, January 14.** If you do not cancel your registration or pay your fees by the fee payment deadline, you will remain registered, you will be charged course fees, and you will be assessed a \$50 late penalty.

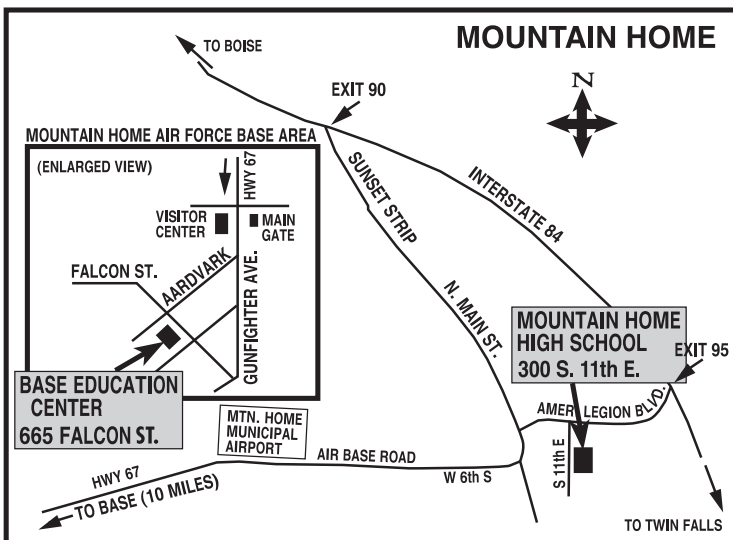
INTERNET CLASSES FOR MOUNTAIN HOME/MILITARY STUDENTS
