4. Provide ample preparation for appropriate performance opportunities.

ATTENDANCE POLICY:

Because of our limited rehearsal time I expect a complete commitment from each individual in this group. Please practice your music consistently and with quality. You must be prepared and ready to work at each Monday, Wednesday, and Friday rehearsal.

1. Excused absences: illness or life/death emergencies which when possible have been cleared with me prior to rehearsal.
2. Unexcused absences: any absence not brought to my attention or not deemed excusable by the conductor. Two unexcused absences will result in the lowering of one's grade by a "+ or -". The director also reserves the right to dismiss a student from the ensemble for attendance problems or lack of preparedness. Concerts and dress rehearsals are mandatory. Any student failing to attend a dress rehearsal for a concert will not play the performance and upon the discretion of the conductor will more than likely fail the class.

REHEARSAL POLICY:

1. Please have a pencil on your stand and ready to use. We work quickly in our rehearsals.
2. Each individual should have their own set of parts. Music will be bowed(string players) and marked to the best of my ability ahead of rehearsal times. Be ready to make any changes during rehearsal times watching your section leaders.
3. I will tell you in advance what to prepare for the next rehearsal. Please practice those sections which are most difficult. Ensemble rehearsals are not the time to practice your music individually. Come prepared and ready to make music!
4. Rehearsals will begin promptly and end promptly.

With our collective hard work and dedication we will perform well and have a most enjoyable musical experience together. I will give 100% dedication and preparedness to making this a group we can all be proud of. I will expect the same commitment from each of you. I'm looking forward to working closely with each of you!
