

Cross Parking and Inter-Session Parking

Cross Parking is defined as the time when permit holders are allowed to park in permit areas other than the one they are normally assigned. For example, General Permit holders may park in Reserved Lots and Reserved Permit Holders may park in other Reserved Lots or General Lots.

Keep in mind however: The Administration Lot and the Parking Garages are always pay lots if you do not have the required permit.

Cross parking is permitted after 5:00PM – 12:30AM Monday through Friday and all day long on Saturdays and Sundays. All General and Reserve permit holders may park in lots noted as General or Reserve on the Campus Parking Map.

Inter-session parking is an extended period of time when cross parking is permitted. Inter-session parking is allowed during the following times:

- ***Thanksgiving holiday week***
- ***Winter Break, Spring Break,***
- ***Break between the last summer session and the beginning of fall semester***
- ***Any holiday the University is closed.***
