

West Stadium Parking Lot Changes Due to Stadium Construction

Parking and Transportation Services has been advised that construction activities for the Bronco Stadium Skyboxes and Suites will begin around Feb. 11th 2007. In meetings with the contractor, the University has expressed a strong desire to minimize the amount of parking spaces lost due to construction activities, while ensuring there is enough room for the project to proceed safely. Further meetings with the contractor may alter parking plans, but as of now we wish to present the following draft information:

- Currently there are 273 General parking spaces in the West Stadium Lot in addition to Student Housing resident parking RH1 and RH2.
- On or around February 11th 2007, construction fence will be set up near the stadium. **This will reduce the number of General parking spaces in the West Stadium lot to 166.** We are calling this Phase 1.
- On or around April 11th 2007, construction fencing will expand **reducing the number of General spaces to 95.** We are calling this Phase 2.
- **Only 95 General spaces will be available beginning April 11th 2007 and potentially continuing until August 2008. This will make general parking in the West Stadium very limited and we expect the lot will be full early each morning. We encourage general permit holders arriving after 7:30 AM to look for parking in the East Stadium and South Campus lots.**
- No changes are planned for RH1, TBA, or ROTC parking areas. We encourage RH1 permit holders to Caesar Chavez Lane to avoid construction traffic.
- RH2 parking will be displaced from adjacent to the west side of the stadium and move towards the center of the lot per phase 1 drawing.
- In addition to the attached maps and estimated dates, Parking will also be working on e-mail reminders, placing notices on vehicles and signs in the parking lot to help everyone understand the changes. Questions about parking can be directed to Parking at 426-PARK.
- We encourage all to consider the use of alternative and mass transportation, such as the free city bus rides, bicycling, car pool and van pool.
- To help off set the displacement of General parking spaces, Parking recently opened about 120 General spaces at the University Inn, and an additional 80 spaces is being developed at Lincoln Ave and Belmont St. Parking will continue to look for additional general parking opportunities. Also in August 2007 we expect our next parking structure located at University Dr. and Lincoln Ave to open, offering 750 more parking spaces which will dramatically assist in providing parking during the construction year of 2008.
- We understand this project will be an inconvenience for many motorists and we appreciate your patience and cooperation.
