
RESIDENCE HALL/APARTMENT ADMINISTRATIVE CONTRACT CANCELLATION

PURPOSE: To establish procedures for psychiatric withdrawals from the residence halls/apartments, and or the University, for behaviors threatening to self or others.

I. Definition

The administrative cancellation of a residence hall or apartment contract is the voiding of that contractual relationship of a Boise State University student who has exhibited behavior which:

- A. constitutes a clear and present danger to self and/or others; or
- B. is unduly disruptive and/or threatening to the residents and staff in the on-campus residential community.

II. Procedure for Item I-A

If the Director of Student Residential Life, in consultation with his/her staff, considers a residence hall or University apartment student to be psychologically dangerous to self, others, and/or University property, (s)he will forward a written recommendation to the Vice-President for Student Affairs that an immediate psychiatric withdrawal from the residence hall/apartment and/or University be considered. The Vice-President will initiate the establishment procedure to respond to such a recommendation (see [BSU 4180](#)).

III. Procedure for Item I-B

If the Director of Student Residential Life, in consultation with his/her staff, and after a conference with the student in question, considers the continued presence of a residence hall or apartment student to be unduly disruptive and/or threatening to other students and/or staff, (s)he will forward a recommendation to the Vice-President for Student Affairs that the student be moved out of the residence hall or apartment immediately. The purpose of such action will be to prevent continuing disruptions and/or intimidating behaviors toward other residents. The student in question can also be charged with a violation of University regulations, the Student Code of Conduct and/or city, state, or federal statutes. In such instances, the student will be accorded appropriate due process.

If the Vice-President for Student Affairs concurs with a recommendation, the Director of Student Residential Life will initiate the action.
