
ADDITIONAL BACCALAUREATE DEGREE AND/OR DOUBLE MAJOR

PURPOSE: To establish requirements for an additional baccalaureate degree and/or double major.

I. Requirements for Additional Baccalaureate Degree

- A. A minimum of thirty (30) additional semester hours of resident work beyond the hours acquired for the first degree is required for each subsequent degree. This applies to double majors if a student is earning two different types of degrees (e.g., BBA in Accounting and BA in English). Double majors earned simultaneously that result in the same degree (e.g., BA in English and History) do not require the additional thirty semester hours.
- B. Satisfaction of all requirements in the major field selected as recommended by the department is required for the additional degree. University Core requirements and English Competency Exam are not required for second and subsequent baccalaureate degrees.

II. Requirements for Double Major

A student may be granted a single baccalaureate degree with more than one major providing that all requirements are satisfied for each major field as recommended by the academic department as well as all requirements for the degree sought.
