1 STUDENT UNION BUILDING (SUB)

This is one of the most active buildings on our campus and we recommend you start your tour here. The SUB houses various student organizations and business offices, including Admissions, our Games Center (complete with a bowling alley, pool tables and more), the Bronco Shop and several restaurants, including Buster's Kitchen, one of the main cafeterias on campus.

2 RECREATION CENTER

Just across the street from the Student Union, you'll find our awardwinning, 105,000 square foot Student Recreation Center (Rec Center). The best part? You receive a free membership as a full-time, fee-paying student. The Rec features basketball courts, exercise and weight rooms, racquetball courts, an indoor running track, group fitness classes, an aquatics center, and climbing wall. Make sure to check out the Outdoor Program located on the first floor for opportunities to get outside.

3 ALBERTSONS STADIUM

Famous for our Blue Turf, Albertsons Stadium is home to our Boise State football team. Stop in to the Allen Noble Hall of Fame for a quick athletic history lesson, then snap a picture in front of the iconic turf. Go Broncos! See more on page 7.

4 FIRST YEAR VILLAGE

Take a stroll from the stadium past ExtraMile Arena (home of our Bronco sports teams and host location for various large concerts and events) and through our First Year Village. Here you'll find six of our first year residence halls. See page 16 for more information about on-campus housing options.

5 ALBERTSONS LIBRARY

The next stop is our library, where you'll find study rooms, comfy "cocoon" chairs and gorgeous views of the Boise River. In addition to books, periodicals, research databases, textbooks and documents, you'll find the largest map collection in The West right here. The higher you go in the library, the better the views of downtown and the Boise River.

6 THE QUAD

The Quad is the center of our campus geographically and one of the busiest areas on campus. It's also right next to the Administration Building, which houses offices such as Financial Aid and Scholarships, Student Financial Services and the Registrar. Our solar-powered charging station is also nearby if your phone needs a quick charge.



Friendship Bridge symbolizes the friendship between Boise State and the city of Boise and connects campus to the surrounding area. Downtown from here is just a quick 15-minute walk.

8 INTERACTIVE LEARNING CENTER (ILC)

Wander around this building to get a sense of what Boise State classes are like. This building holds study rooms and classrooms on floors 2-4, a lecture hall on the first floor and dining options.



Home to the Department of Art, Design and Visual Studies, this building is a show-stopper. Here you'll find our World Museum, art galleries, studios and incredible views of downtown and the foothills.

10 MICRON BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS BUILDING

Full of modern classrooms and study spaces, this building houses our College of Business and Economics (otherwise known as COBE) as well as the Skaggs Hall of Learning, one of our largest lecture halls on campus.
