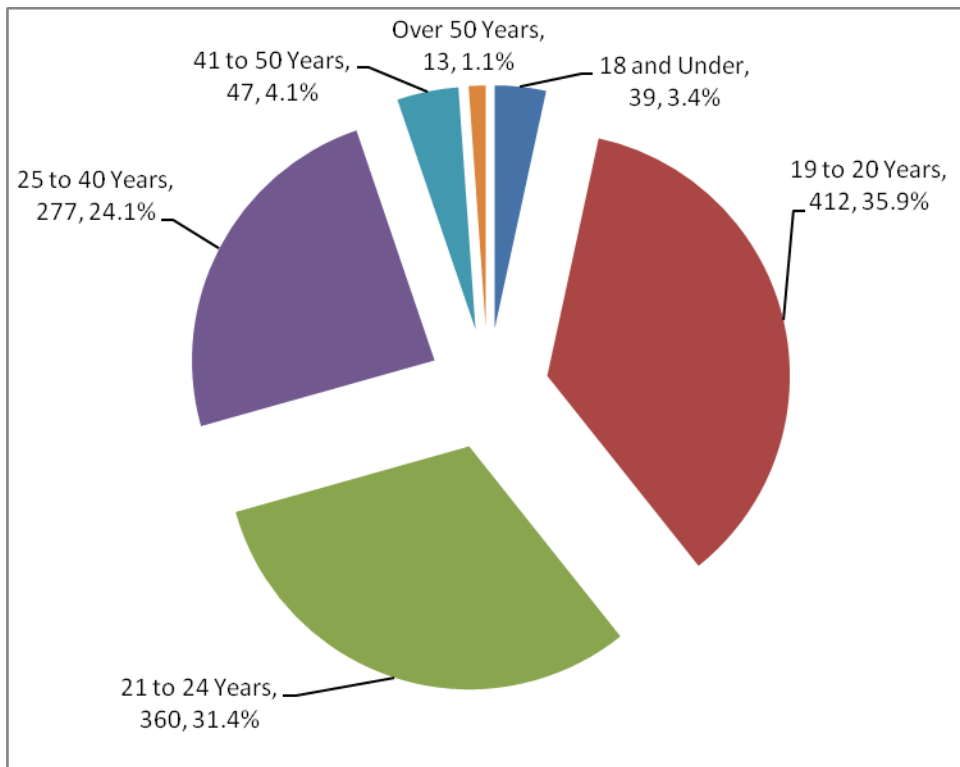

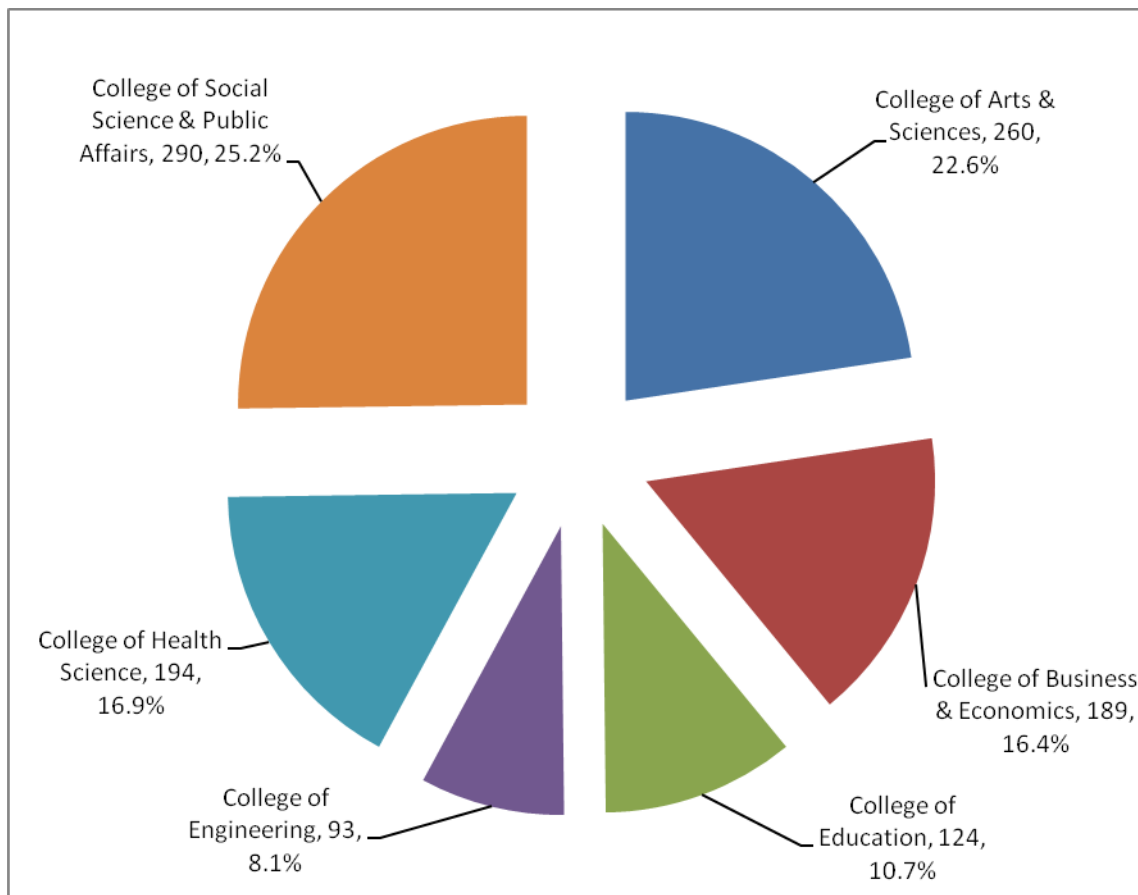

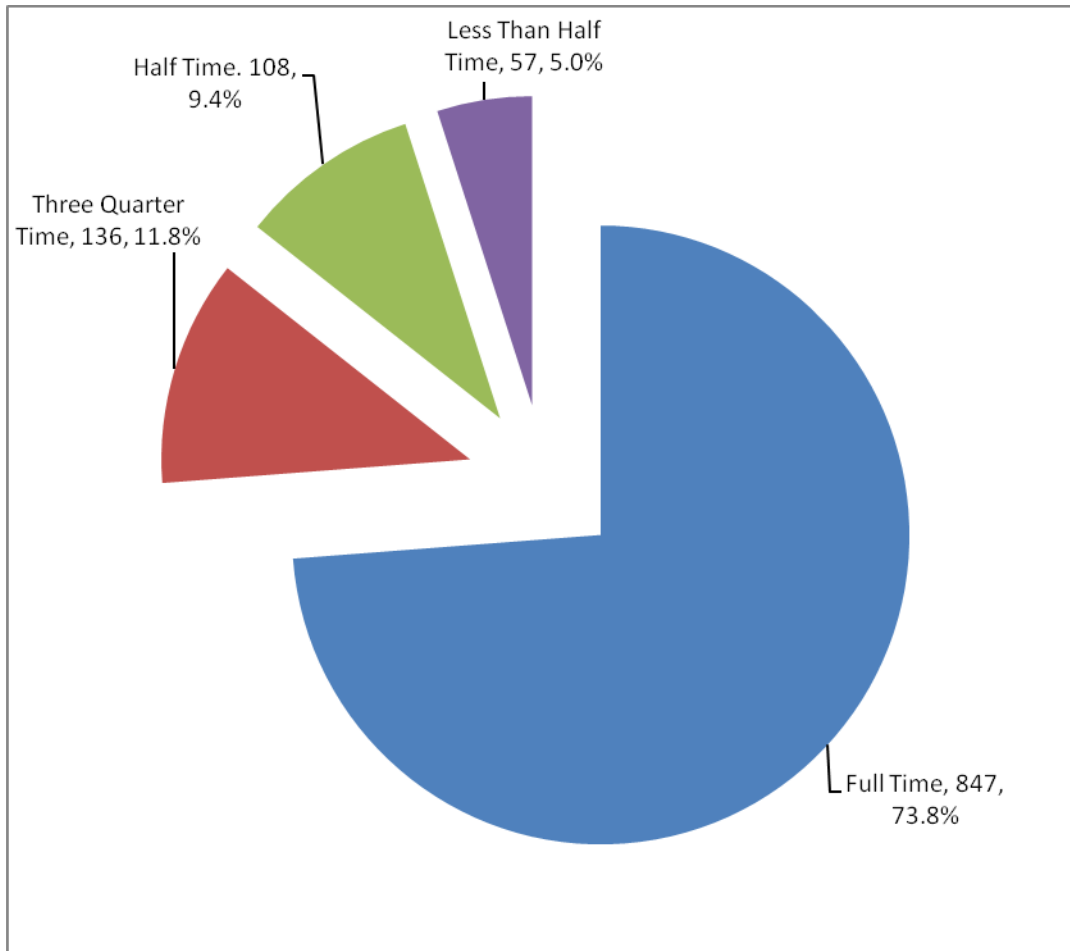

This report only includes cohorts of new transfer students (ASSOCXFER, BACHXFER, CERTXFER). Applications and admitted student numbers stated in this report include all transfer applicants and admitted students, not just first-time degree seeking transfer students.
