
Math Placement and Progression



Math Placement - Your highest test score to date will always be used.

Notes:

- 1. You may use test scores or complete a prerequisite course for placement.
- 2. You do not need to take the most advanced class for which you qualify, but you need to complete the appropriate math path for your major--see your catalog.
- 3. Your department may recommend a specific math path. Check with your advisor.

If you do not have a standardized test (ACT or SAT) score or transfer math credit, you will need to take the Accuplacer for placement purposes. You may also elect to take the Accuplacer exam if:

- You think you may be able to place higher than your current placement, especially if you are going into a major with a greater emphasis on math, such as engineering, business, health sciences, or natural/physical sciences.
- You have not taken a math class in a while and feel uncertain about how much you remember and can apply in class.
