Scope and Audience

This policy applies to all student declarations of academic majors.

1. Policy Purpose

To establish University policy for student declaration of an academic major.

2. Policy Statement

A student seeking a baccalaureate degree must declare a major field of study by the time they are classified as a junior.

3. Responsibilities and Procedures

3.1 Classification of Junior Status

A student seeking a baccalaureate degree will be classified as a junior when fifty-eight (58) credits have been earned.

3.2 Deadline for Declaration of Academic Major

Students seeking a baccalaureate degree must declare a major when they are classified as a junior.

3.3 Changes to Major

Students may change their major at any time. However, students in programs with upperdivision admissions standards must be formally admitted to the program to officially claim it as a major.
