Career Planning Assistance

Get Help In-Person:

- Individual Appointments: Meet with a career counselor for individualized career planning assistance. Schedule your appointment online at boisestate.joinhandshake.com/appointments.
- Career Assessments: Several career assessments are available through our office, including Sigi 3 (no cost), the Myers-Briggs Type Indicator, the Strong Interest Inventory, and CliftonStrengths for Students. To take an assessment, first schedule an appointment using the link above.
- Career Events: Career Fairs and Employer Information Sessions are a great way to expand your network, explore future opportunities, and research how to make yourself competitive for future positions. Watch for emails from the Career Center and your academic department about upcoming events.
